

Post Workshop Activity

Road Safety at School

Timing: Flexible 60 minutes +

Learning Intentions

- To develop tangible community plan ideas to address road safety as a school
- To engage other cohorts, teachers, leaders and the wider school community on important road safety topics

Activity Description

At the end of the face to face F2D workshop, students came up with a list of community plan ideas to raise awareness about road safety in settings such as their school, workplace, sports and other clubs, and among their family and friends. To empower students to action some of these ideas, this activity helps to continue the conversation about road safety by tasking students to develop a multimedia creation to promote within the school, specifically in relation to a road safety idea that is important to them.

Instructions

BRAINSTORM

1. Write two headings on a whiteboard titled 'Road Risks' and 'Community Plan Ideas'.
2. Ask students to recall and brainstorm some of the Road Risks that were discussed at the beginning of the face to face F2D workshop, and some of the Community Plan Ideas that they came up with at the end of the workshop. **These ideas can be used for the next activity, or as a starting point.**

GENERATE

Individually or in pairs, have students choose:

1. An idea that they would like to promote on the roads. For example: power naps, designated drivers, seatbelts, carpooling, public transport and other safe ways home. **OR**
2. An idea that they would like to see less of on the roads. For example: speeding, drink/drug driving, mobile phone use, seatbelts, fatigue, road rage.

CREATE

Task students to develop a multimedia creation (Poster or Video) incorporating the following:

1. The name of their idea, a catch phrase or a slogan.
2. A brief description of what they're promoting or what they would like to reduce on the roads.
3. At least **one** fact or statistic related to their road safety topic.
4. A detailed suggestion to encourage the school to take action in relation to their topic.
